Lesvos Solidarity is seeking a compassionate and dedicated **Psychologist** to join our Mental Health and Psychosocial Support (MHPSS) team. The successful candidate will play a key role in designing, implementing, and delivering mental health services to both local and refugee communities, promoting emotional well-being, resilience, and social integration.

### Key Responsibilities

- **Service Delivery:** Provide individual, family, and group psychological support and counselling sessions to improve the mental health and psychosocial well-being of beneficiaries.
- **Project Design & Implementation:** Actively contribute to the design and implementation of the MHPSS project, ensuring interventions are evidence-based and culturally appropriate.
- **Case Management:** Collaborate with colleagues to develop and implement case management plans tailored to each beneficiary's needs.
- **Crisis Response:** Respond promptly and appropriately to mental health emergencies.
- **Community Activities:** Plan, monitor, and facilitate educational, recreational, and integration activities in collaboration with team members (e.g., social workers, educational facilitators).

- **Data & Reporting:** Collect, analyze, and monitor data on mental health activities; produce regular (weekly/monthly) reports.
- **Ethical Practice:** Maintain strict confidentiality and ensure all ethical standards are upheld in line with professional guidelines.
- **Team Collaboration:** Participate in regular case discussions with social workers, supervisors, and coordinators to ensure holistic support for beneficiaries.
- **Representation:** Represent the MHPSS department in relevant coordination or working groups (e.g., Protection, MHPSS).
- **Adaptability:** Support other project-related tasks as required, demonstrating flexibility and commitment to the evolving needs of the program.

## Qualifications

- **Bachelor's degree in psychology** (master's degree preferred).
- Experience working with **migrant or refugee populations**.
- Experience working with **interpreters** (preferred).
- **Good spoken and written English**; knowledge of Greek is required; other languages is an asset.
- Strong ability to **work independently** while maintaining collaboration within a multidisciplinary team.
- Commitment to humanitarian values, confidentiality, and professional ethics.
